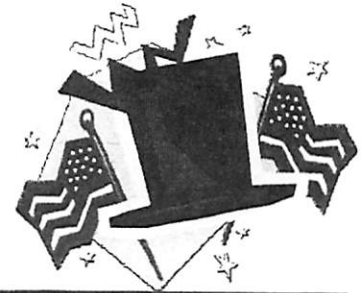

Introducing the Locals:

This year the **Locals** would like to try something just a little different at Train Mountain. First let's set the scene: Suppose you want to go to another club for their train meet. That train meet would of course be run by that local club. They would have already had their own workweeks before the meet so that all you would do at the meet is enjoy the companionship, run your train, and enjoy whatever else the club had to offer. At Train Mountain we have a much different situation, as our members are from all over the world. Our members are our guests and our guests are our members. Our members come to here enjoy the meets just as at any other club, but we must also ask them to do a little work before hand in order to even have the meet. So here is what the **Locals** are going to try and do this year.

The **Locals** would like to act as the hosting club for each of the Train Mountain workweeks and meets this year. Most clubs have visiting engines and crews at their meets, but at Train Mountain we sometimes have as many as a hundred engines and crews visiting. Well we just don't have that large of a local group to run that size of a meet, especially 4 of them in a single year! So the **Locals** will undertake the role of organizing and overseeing the meets and workweeks; what we ask in return is your help in helping to make it happen. The **Locals** will try and have the work weeks organized so that when you arrive you will know what is going on and where it is going to happen. The good news is that we have 30+ miles of track now, but the bad news is that we have 30+ miles of maintenance to do! The **Locals** will be working on some projects in between the meets so that for the work weeks there probably won't be major work parties; but there will be jobs that can be done by train and that can be done by most members. The **Locals** will also have some jobs less strenuous than track maintenance for members to do. The **Locals** will be sporting yellow shirts lettered **Local**. They can assist you in locating a work crew and a project.

If you can't make the work weeks or meets but can come between those times; please go to the Main Office at Central Station and look on the front counter for a little box. Inside this box will be 3x5 cards with projects listed on them. These projects will be outlined by the **Locals** between now and the first meet. Look through the cards and pick out a project you would like to work on and take the card with you. Upon completion of the job, please write down what you did, who worked with you on the project, how much time it took you, etc. Sign it, and turn it in at the office. With your continued help and the **Locals** we can keep Train Mountain running as smoothly as you would like to have it. It can't work with out your help.

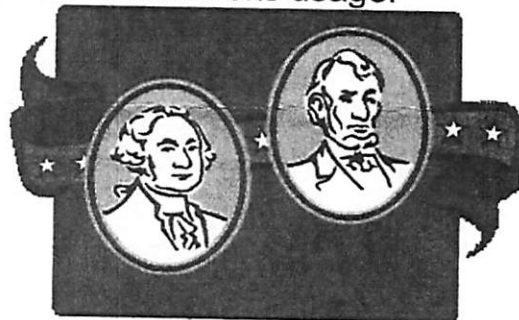
