Message from the locals:

Train Mountain has received inquiries regarding the 'Locals'.

First, the locals report to Train Mountain. The projects that are being overseen by the locals are those volunteer projects that may have been asked for by FTM, Train Mountain or Timberlake. They also include projects that have been researched by the locals as they run on the railroad. They come in basically three categories.

First is repair, those things that have been broken through the winter. Second are those things that need to be replaced, because they are simply worn out from use. Lastly, are those projects that as we gain more experience at running Train Mountain, we need to accomplish to make things a little easier for all of us. Examples of some of these projects are: Fixing some broken switch throws (cat. 1), Replacing some worn out rail and a switch frog or two (cat. 2), Laying a spur into the new burn pit just west of South Portal (cat. 3). All projects are then reviewed and prioritized jointly by Train Mountain and the locals. If you are interested in working on some of these projects, simply let Train Mountain know when you are coming. When you arrive check the little task box in the front office, the white board in Central Station or look for a local to assist you. (Continued on Page 4)
